How can you help?

This year our badge days are **completely free** to attend. Instead of charging a fee, we're simply asking that, if you're able to, your child brings **one brand-new gift** to donate.

It's a small act that could make a *huge* difference.

Donation Guidelines:

- Gifts should be **new and in their original packaging**
- **Please don't wrap them** the charity sorts gifts by age and gender
- No food or chocolate, please
- If the gift needs batteries, please attach them to the outside of the box

What kind of gifts are welcome?

Cash for Kids supports children and young people aged **0 to 18**, so a wide range of gifts are suitable, including:

- Toys, puzzles, games
- Clothing (all sizes), hats, scarves, socks, gloves
- Toiletries, cosmetics, hair accessories

- Perfume, aftershave, stationery
- Small electrical items (e.g. headphones)

They're especially in need of gifts for:

Babies - bottles, bibs, blankets, teething toys

Teenagers – cosmetics, stationery, electricals
